

Pennsylvania Office of the Attorney General Signs Lawson Software Contract

Officed in Harrisburg, PA, the fundamental duties of the Attorney General are:

- To be the Commonwealth's chief law enforcement officer charged with the responsibility for the prosecution of organized crime and public corruption. This law enforcement effort includes a criminal investigation unit and a drug law enforcement program as well as direction of statewide and multi-county investigating grand juries and a Medicaid Fraud Control Section
- To collect, by suit or otherwise, all debts, taxes and accounts due the Commonwealth which shall be referred to and placed with the Attorney General
- To represent the Commonwealth and all Commonwealth agencies and upon request the Auditor General, State Treasurer and Public Utility Commission in any action brought by or against the Commonwealth or its Agencies
- To administer the provision relating to consumer protection laws
- To represent the Commonwealth and its citizens in any action brought about for violation of the antitrust laws of the United States and the Commonwealth
- To review for form and legality all Commonwealth deeds, leases and contracts to be executed by Commonwealth Agencies
- To furnish upon request legal advice concerning any matter or issue arising in connection with the exercise of the official powers or performance of the official duties of the Governor or the head of any Commonwealth agency
- To review for form and legality all proposed rules and regulations of Commonwealth agencies

Once implemented, the Lawson system will help The Office of the Attorney General streamline employee record maintenance and the processing of new employee applications while enhancing its reporting capabilities.

"Facing similar financial and workforce management challenges as other public sector organizations, public agents need a strong IT foundation to simplify business processes and help reduce administrative costs," said Cheryl Turk-Peterson, marketing director, Public Sector, Lawson.
